Series Theme – Overflow

Series Overview

This 4-part series will be split into 2 sections: Personal and Collective overflow. It will start by looking at our own hearts and will then move onto how this looks for us to overflow as a church family, as a collective, posturing our hearts towards holiness in order to allow his overflow. This lines up with a number of prophetic words through the stream around the posture of holiness being key for the next season and the Lord bringing overflow. We are looking internally but through the lens of what's coming (flowing) out.

Key Series Wins

For the Believer: To allow the Holy Spirit to fill us daily in order to overflow and outwork our personal and collective purpose.

Message 1 – Personal- The heart

Scripture: Proverbs 27:19, Proverbs 21:2, Ma

Know What? To understand what is meant by 'the heart' and what a healthy heart looks like because out of it flows all of our actions.

So What? Our hearts are the intersection between our body and spirit and it is important that we intentionally protect and preserve the good things in it and keep out the bad. Having an 'unhealthy heart' has negative affects both physically and spiritually. To understand our hearts were created by God, for God.

Now What? To intentionally guard our hearts and to keep them healthy.

Where is Jesus? He is the heart and he knows our hearts, nothing is hidden from him.

Message 2- Personal- How the heart flows

Scriptures: Proverbs 4:23, Luke 6:45, Matt 12:34, John 7:38, Psalm 139:23

Know What? Knowing that whatever fills the heart come out of it. We are called to overflow out of the abundance of what we've been given. God never intended for it to just be for ourselves.

So What? We are going to overflow what is in our heart regardless of whether that is good or bad, we want healthy hearts because we want to overflow good and positive things.

Now What? To surrender to the Holy Spirit for a heart MOT. To enable what's good and God to flow through your heart. To discover any 'heart blockages' that are preventing the overflow.

Where is Jesus? *Jesus is the one who knows, searches, fills and cleanses our hearts.*

Message 3- Collective- Alignment and posturing together

Scriptures: 1 Thessalonians 3:12-13

Know What? To take our individual hearts and align them together under Jesus. A collective posturing of our hearts towards holiness in order to allow his overflow.

So What? We want to overflow as a church family into this community and we cannot do this if we aren't aligned or postured under the holiness together. We are all accountable to each other in living a life honouring to God.

Now What? A commitment to spiritual growth and growing in holiness together through community groups. A commitment to each other and yourself.

Where is Jesus? We are only holy with Jesus.

Message 4- Collective- The Missional aspect of overflow

Scripture: 1 Peter 1:15-16, 2 Corinthians 5:20, Colossians 3:12

Know What? To understand that the way we outpour together, impacts our mission. To understand the outpouring of the spirit and our spiritual gifts as part of the mission.

So What? We exist for mission. The overflow is to enable others to find life-find Jesus.

Now What? To recommit to the mission and living a life that is holy and acceptable to God. To be the overflow that God is willing you to be.

Where is Jesus? *Jesus is at the centre of our mission. We are holy because he is holy.*
