Series Theme: Unshakable Foundations

Series Overview

This series is aimed to remind people regardless of where they are on the journey, of the truth of who God is. We want to encourage everyone to anchor themselves firmly in the unshakeable foundations. To trust in Gods goodness, rely on His word, to walk in faith honoring His covenant and extend His gifts to others.

Within this series we have to understand that some listening may have no concept of these ideas presented so there is a need to explain simply what the important foundations are.

Key Series Wins

For believers the aim/win is to: To have a reality check on what our foundations are. Are we unshakable? Things will come to rock us but what are we stood on? What platform have we got for God to do the next thing on?

For non-believers the aim/win is for them to: To know who God is so they can build foundations into life that will make them unshakable in God and create a platform for what God wants to do in their life.

Scripture: Psalm 100 v 5, Psalm 34:8, Mark 10:18, James 1:17, Matthew 11:7,

Focus: Exploring the unshakeable foundation of God's goodness, emphasising how His character anchors our faith and understanding.

Key Points: Highlighting the unwavering nature of God's goodness as the bedrock of our Christian journey, fostering trust and confidence in His promises.

Where is Jesus: Jesus is the outworking of Gods goodness to rescue us from our sin.

Message 2 – September 8th: The Power of the Word

Scripture: Hebrews 4:12, John 1:1, Psalm 119:105, Matthew 4:4

Focus: Delving into the transformative power of God's Word, demonstrating its ability to shape our beliefs, thoughts, and actions.

Key Points: Illustrating how the Word of God provides stability and direction in our lives, guiding us through challenges and uncertainties. History of the bible/the word of God – what it is and some context around the Bible as the word of God.

Where is Jesus: He is the living breathing active word.

Message 3 – September 15th – Faith

Scripture: Romans 10:17, 2 Corinthians 5:7, Hebrews 11:1, Matthew 17:19-20, Mark 11:22

Focus: Examining the indispensable role of faith in our walk with God, emphasising its necessity for spiritual growth and manifestation of God's promises.

Key Points: Discussing how faith serves as the bridge between the unseen and the seen, empowering believers to overcome obstacles and receive God's blessings. Highlight what Faith is and what it isn't.

Where is Jesus: He's who we put our faith in – the word, the truth, and the life.

Message 4 – September 22nd – Promises (Covenant & Contract)

Scripture: Hebrews 8:6, Deuteronomy 7:6-11, Ephesians 2:12-13, 2 Peter 1:3-4

Focus: Exploring the concept of covenant as a promise, and its significance in our relationship with God, highlighting His faithfulness to fulfil His promises.

Key Points: Discussing how God's covenant with His people provides security and assurance, underscoring the importance of our commitment to Him. Looking at the difference between the old and new covenant God gave to his people can go back to the basics on what the contract/covenant is and how it enables relationship with him.

Where is Jesus – Jesus fulfilled the old covenant on our behalf, his death and resurrection created a new covenant with God that is unbreakable for us.

<u>Message 5 – September 29th - Gift of Giving – Grace, Mercy, Love,</u> and Forgiveness

Scriptures: Philippians 2:3-4, Luke 12:38

Focus: Reflecting on the profound gifts of grace, mercy, love, and forgiveness bestowed upon us by God, inspiring us to extend the same to others.

Key Points: Emphasising the transformative power of God's gifts in our lives, motivating us to be vessels of His love and grace in the world. We are not here for us; we are part of a bigger story. There is a different way of living.

Where is Jesus: Jesus gave his all – Grace, mercy, love, and forgiveness. He is the example we should try to follow, and he gave us the Holy Spirit to help us.
