

Mini Series for Summer – Reset & Ready

Series Overview: As we pause at the midpoint of the year, this two-part series invites us to intentionally reflect on where we have been and prepare for where God is leading us. Firstly, to look back with honesty and gratitude, celebrating God's faithfulness while allowing Him to search our hearts, realign our priorities, and bring us back to Jesus. In the second part, we look forward with faith, releasing nostalgia, surrendering control, and positioning ourselves to embrace the new thing God is doing. Together, these messages remind us that following Jesus is a continual rhythm of reflection, repentance, gratitude, surrender, and courageous obedience. As we are realigned with Christ, we become ready to step into His purposes with renewed confidence, trusting that the One who has been faithful is already preparing the way ahead.

Key Wins:

For Believers To realign ourselves with Jesus, give over any areas of control and celebrate God's faithfulness and the growth we have already seen before stepping ready into a new season with expectancy for what God wants to do next.

For Un-believers to discover that there is a God who can search them, forgive them and give them a new beginning, that Jesus invites everyone to follow him into a life of purpose.

Message 1 – Reset

Scriptures: Psalm 139: 23-24, Lamentations 3:40, 2 Corinthians 13:15

Focus: As we reach the midpoint of the year, we pause before rushing into the next season. This is a moment to look back honestly, give thanks for God's faithfulness, celebrate how far He has brought us, and allow the Holy Spirit to realign our hearts with Jesus. The scriptures encourage us to invite God to search our hearts, to examine us and to choose repentance over routine, to test ourselves and see if we are living in faith.

Key Points: Look back with honesty not condemnation, recognising God's faithfulness, give thanks and celebrate – honour the victories growth and transformation before resetting. Resetting is not starting over, it is returning our hearts and priorities to Jesus, realignment means bringing every area of life back under His lordship so we can move forward with clarity and obedience.

Where is Jesus: Jesus dwells within His people, he is the one who searches our hearts and he is the one we can trust to lead us into a renewed purpose and deeper intimacy.

Message 2 – Ready

Scriptures: Joshua 1:9, Isaiah 43: 18-19, Proverbs 3: 5-6

Focus: As God leads us into a new season, He invites us to move forward with faith rather than familiarity. Preparation is not simply waiting for what comes next but positioning our hearts and trusting God to lead. We cannot embrace the new things if we remain attached to yesterday's success, disappointment or comfort. This is a call to surrender control, let go of nostalgia and follow with confidence Jesus. We can trust Jesus with all our hearts and plans and allow him to direct our path.

Key Points: We can celebrate what God has done without building our future around it, Nostalgia can become an obstacle to what God wants to do next. We can trust Jesus when we surrender our control, and choose obedience over certainty. God doesn't promise every new season will be easy but he does promise he will be with us wherever we go.

Where is Jesus: Jesus is the one who leads us, who calls us to trust him and follow him. He modelled complete surrender to the fathers will, showing us security isn't found in control but in obedience.
